AUTHORIZATION FOR PROBATION OFFICERS
TO CARRY FIREARMS

IT IS ORDERED THAT,

To insure their safety the probation officers of this Court on occasion require the use of firearms in the execution of their duties. Therefore, it is ordered that when qualified and when specifically authorized by the Chief U. S. Probation Officer, and in compliance of such other conditions as may be prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, each regularly appointed probation officer of this Court is authorized to carry a firearm for the protection of his or her person during the performance of his or her duties.
